Residential Care



Terry Yorath House is a single storey, purpose built home, providing residential and respite care and support for people aged between 18 – 65 who have physical and/or learning disabilities. A committed and appropriately trained staff team provide support 24-hours per day.



Each person we support has a personal development plan to ensure that their programme of support is individually tailored, and choices are recorded and carried out according to their wishes and needs.

Accommodation

The home is purpose built to a high specification with twelve bedrooms and a range of shared areas including a large lounge and dining area, and spacious gardens. Bedrooms are furnished and decorated to people's personal choice.

Support Team

A competent, caring and committed staff team is available to meet the needs of those who use our services. Training and development of staff is a key priority for us to ensure service delivery is of the highest standard.

Terry Yorath House, like all SJOG services, is led by the people who use its services and individuals are encouraged to play a central part in the running of the service.

Support

People are supported to access a wide variety of leisure and social activities of their choice and develop skills:

Living skills - cooking, shopping, laundry, personal safety, rights and responsibilities.

Community living - finding out about services near their home including day services, accessing social and community activities, advocacy support, travel and holidays.

Respite

There are two rooms within the home to accommodate guests on a respite basis. These are available on referral by a care manager or by self referral. For further information or to arrange a visit, please contact the service manager at the address on the back page.

Location

The home is situated in the residential area of Roundhay, Leeds close to a number of local amenities and Roundhay Park. These include shops, restaurants, public houses, pharmacy and hairdressers. It has the benefit of being accessible to a comprehensive local transport network.
